Overall Course Objectives

The basic aim of the course was to teach individuals of various organizations (such as: project management firms, NGOs, educational institutions etc.) to develop e-learning courses with strong didactic and pedagogic elements based on free, open and innovative web based tools. It was essentially important that the methods and programs thought in the program allowed both vocational teachers, school teachers and other online learning material developers to acquire innovative and useful knowledge in the topic of e-learning module development.

The specific knowledge and methods used during the course were:

- Mastering the ins and outs of creating an innovative and successful e-Learning modules
- Getting familiar with the specific free web based and multimedia applications for developing exceptional e-Learning courses
- Learning how to transfer the efficiency and knowledge of traditional, face-to-face training into online education and learning
- Understanding the different options available for people with special needs
- Becoming able to provide feedback and troubleshoot the possible problems, issues that can come up with an e-Learning course
- Establishing a network of potential partners or clients from all over Europe and considering other educational and cultural differences
- Upon completing the course successfully, candidates receive an official certificate, which is acknowledged City and Guilds/Institute of Leadership and Management. This is the only training course in the area of eLearning in whole Europe that is endorsed by the international vocational award body City and Guilds/Institute of Leadership and Management.

- TAP-Training Action Plan

TUESDAY:

- How to choose the right kind of platform?
- Analyzing the structure and operation of different e-Learning platforms
- Introduction to Moodle and Moodle Cloud

WEDNESDAY:

- Additional e-Learning course analysis
- Moodle course development from scratch

THURSDAY and FRIDAY:

- Structuring Moodle courses individually
- Executing complex e-Learning tasks in Moodle
- Creating a complete Moodle course in small teams and presenting the results
